5 Relating to a Legislative Council
6 study of the Alaska Industrial
7 Incentive Act.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS many questions have been posed recently regarding the
10 effectiveness and suitability of the Alaska Industrial Incentive
11 Act (AS 43.25); and

12 WHEREAS appropriate state programs, which fairly accommodate
13 the interests of the local governments in Alaska, to encourage
14 the establishment of new industry are mandatory if the state's
15 economy is to continue to grow; and

16 WHEREAS any problems which exist regarding the policy or
17 provisions of the Alaska Industrial Incentive Act, which is one of
18 the principal programs which the state now relies upon to attract
19 new industry, deserves immediate attention;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
21 prepare and present to the Legislature in January, 1967, a
22 comprehensive study on the Alaska Industrial Incentive Act which
23 shall include information regarding its operation, an evaluation
24 of its performance to date, and recommendations for changes or
25 alternatives to the Act. The Council shall solicit the comments
26 and suggestions of the political subdivisions of the state, as
27 well as those of state officials responsible for administering the
28 present Act, during the preparation of the study.
