3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the initiation of a  
6 program of self-insurance by the  
7 State of Alaska for its employees  
8 for purposes of workmen's  
9 compensation.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS all employees of the State of Alaska are subject to  
12 coverage under the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act; and

13 WHEREAS the state does not maintain a program of self-  
14 insurance under the provisions of the Alaska Workmen's Compensa-  
15 tion Act, but relies on coverage by various out-of-state insurance  
16 companies; and

17 WHEREAS the initiation of a program of self-insurance by the  
18 state would provide for the most efficient management of the pro-  
19 gram, and at the local level; and

20 WHEREAS a program of self-insurance would facilitate the  
21 administration of the program and permit the most expeditious  
22 settlement of claims; and

23 WHEREAS the initiation of a program of self-insurance would  
24 enable the state to keep a greater portion of its resources in  
25 the state;

26 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully urged to  
27 request the Commissioner of Administration to take the necessary  
28 measures to institute procedures whereby the State of Alaska may  
29 engage in a program of self-insurance under the provisions of the
