5 Relating to the assistance and  
6 cooperation of the state with a  
7 statewide legal aid program.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS a statewide legal aid program is being developed  
10 to provide assistance to those persons who cannot afford to pay  
11 for it; and

12 WHEREAS there is a 90 per cent federal contribution toward  
13 the cost of the program with a 10 per cent contribution by the  
14 state which may be in money or by contribution of facilities and  
15 services; and

16 WHEREAS there will be a need for office space, and trans-  
17 portation within the state, particularly in the remote areas of  
18 the state;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the state assist the legal aid program  
20 by making available for the use of the legal aid staff, office  
21 space or facilities owned or leased by the state; and that  
22 regular trips of state-owned or state-chartered aircraft carry  
23 the staff of the legal aid program when there is space available;  
24 and that all state departments cooperate with the legal aid  
25 program in order that the state's 10 per cent contribution can  
26 come from existing state facilities and services where possible.
