5 Relating to the grant of construc-
6 tion funds from the Hill-Harris
7 program to Wesleyan Hospital.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS Wesleyan Hospital for Chronic Diseases, a private
10 hospital located in the City of Seward, has applied for a match-
11 ing construction grant from the Hill-Harris program in order to
12 build a long-term care facility; and

13 WHEREAS the administrator of Wesleyan Hospital believes that
14 it is not economically feasible for the hospital to continue to
15 serve only tuberculosis patients; and

16 WHEREAS the City of Seward, by City Council Resolution No.
17 509 adopted March 21, 1966, has endorsed and approved the appli-
18 cation of Wesleyan Hospital for matching funds from the Hill-Harris
19 program with which to construct an additional wing to care for
20 long-term, chronic disease patients;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Health Facilities Council of the
22 Alaska Department of Health and Welfare is urged and requested to
23 grant a high priority to the application of Wesleyan Hospital for
24 a matching funds grant from the Hill-Harris program in order that
25 construction of the additional hospital wing may begin before the
26 end of this year's construction season.
