2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 15

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a boat harbor for
6 the City of Hoonah.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS fishing boats in Hoonah have increased to such an
9 extent that crowded conditions are making mooring hazardous; and

10 WHEREAS various boat owners will not moor their boats in
11 Hoonah during the winter months because of the southwest and
12 Glacier Bay winds which do considerable boat damage; and

13 WHEREAS fishermen have the added expense of running their
14 boats south in the fall and north in the spring; and

15 WHEREAS the lack of a small boat harbor is threatening the
16 entire economy of the City of Hoonah; and

17 WHEREAS the Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army made surveys for a
18 small boat harbor in Hoonah in January, 1951 and again in July of
19 1959;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the United States Department of the Army,
21 through the Corps of Engineers, is respectfully urged to construct
22 the small boat harbor at Hoonah at the earliest possible date; and
23 be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
25 the Honorable Cyrus R. Vance, Secretary of the Army; Lt. General
26 Walter K. Wilson, Jr., Chief of Engineers; Colonel Clare D. Farley,
27 District Engineer; and to the members of the Alaska Delegation in
28 Congress.
