3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the location of the  
6 headquarters of the Alaska  
7 Communications System.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Alaska Communications System, U. S. Air Force,  
10 has provided the Territory and State of Alaska and its people  
11 with basic communications service for decades; and

12 WHEREAS this service is intended to provide military and  
13 public communication within Alaska and to link the internal system  
14 with the national communication systems; and

15 WHEREAS the headquarters for this Alaska-based and Alaska-  
16 oriented system is located at Seattle, Washington; and

17 WHEREAS the headquarters of the Alaska Communications System  
18 ought to be in the area in which it is operated and serves;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Alaska Delegation in  
20 Congress are urged to move for the necessary action to move the  
21 headquarters of the Alaska Communications System from Seattle,  
22 Washington, to Alaska; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
24 the Honorable Robert S. McNamara, Secretary of Defense; the  
25 Honorable Eugene M. Zuckert, Secretary of the Air Force; Major  
26 General James C. Jensen, Commander, Alaskan Air Command; and the  
27 members of the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
