3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the Rampart Dam
6 Project.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Field Report on the Rampart Project in Alaska
9 has been prepared from the studies made by the various field
10 agencies of the Department of Interior; and

11 WHEREAS the Corps of Engineers of the United States Army has,
12 for the past five years, been preparing a comprehensive report on
13 the feasibility and consequences of the construction of the
14 Rampart Dam; and

15 WHEREAS upon completion, this project would furnish needed
16 power to areas both within and without the state; and

17 WHEREAS prompt consideration of and action upon the report
18 of the Corps of Engineers is vital to the development of the state
19 and to the welfare of the United States;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior is urged
21 to review and evaluate the Field Report and submit his conclusions
22 and recommendations to the Corps of Engineers; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, United States
24 Army, is urged to submit its report to Congress at the earliest
25 possible moment; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that Congress is urged to authorize and
27 initiate the Rampart Project as part of the 1966 Omnibus Flood
28 Control bill; and be it

29 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to

1 the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; the
2 Honorable Henry M. Jackson, Chairman, Senate Committee on Interior
3 and Insular Affairs; the Honorable Wayne N. Aspinall, Chairman,
4 House Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs; the Honorable
5 Lt. Gen. Walter K. Wilson, Chief of Engineers, United States Army;
6 and the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest
7 Gruening, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers,
8 U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress
