3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Urging immediate enactment of
6 the President's right-to-vote
7 legislation.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS President Lyndon B. Johnson has called upon Congress
10 to immediately enact legislation guaranteeing the right to vote to
11 all citizens regardless of their color, race, creed, or economic
12 condition; and

13 WHEREAS the President today has sent to the Congress the
14 legislation he recommends as being necessary to guarantee this in-
15 alienable right of all citizens to vote; and

16 WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Alaska endorses the
17 recommendations of the President of the United States regarding
18 the legislation needed to insure this inalienable right to all
19 Americans;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska
21 heartily endorses the legislation program of President Lyndon B.
22 Johnson regarding right-to-vote legislation and respectfully urges
23 Congress to enact this legislation with all deliberate speed; and
24 be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be directed
26 to the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the United States,
27 the Honorable Hubert H. Humphrey, Vice President of the United
28 States and President of the Senate; the Honorable Carl Hayden,
29 President pro tempore of the Senate; the Honorable John W.

1 McCormack, Speaker of the House of Representatives; the Honorable
2 E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators,
3 and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative, members
4 of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
