5 Relating to a Joint Commission
6 on Correctional Manpower and
7 Training and H. R. 2263.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Arden House Conference on Manpower and Training
10 for Corrections pointed out a national need for upgrading and
11 improving state correctional programs; and

12 WHEREAS this need is further exemplified by H. R. 2263 which
13 is a federal bill to fund the upgrading of state correctional
14 programs on a national basis; and

15 WHEREAS the upgrading and improvement of state correctional
16 programs would benefit greatly from the operation of a National
17 Joint Commission on Correctional Manpower and Training; and

18 WHEREAS the State of Alaska realizes the need for improved
19 training methods and techniques in the correctional programs;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports
21 the findings of the Arden House Conference on Manpower and
22 Training for Corrections and urges the passage of H. R. 2263 to
23 assist in this national program; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
25 the Honorable Anthony J. Celebrezze, Secretary of the Department
26 of Health, Education and Welfare; and the Honorable E. L. Bartlett
27 and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators, and the
28 Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative, members of the
29 Alaska delegation in Congress.
