2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 52

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting Congress to act  
6 favorably on an appropriation to  
7 retire or adjust individual  
8 mortgages on homes lost in the  
9 Alaska earthquake.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS there is pending in Congress a proposal for the  
12 appropriation of \$5.5 million to retire or adjust individual  
13 mortgages on homes destroyed by the Alaska earthquake of March 27,  
14 1964; and

15 WHEREAS this appropriation is essential to the full recovery  
16 of the State of Alaska's economy in both the private and public  
17 sectors which incurred unprecedented losses in 1964; and

18 WHEREAS the progress made in the public sector must be  
19 matched by a realistic program for the private sector if Alaska  
20 is to recover and progress; and

21 WHEREAS the State of Alaska has committed itself to the  
22 support of this assistance to the recovery of the private sector;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that Congress is respectfully and most  
24 urgently requested to appropriate the \$5.5 million necessary to  
25 retire or adjust individual mortgages on homes destroyed by the  
26 Alaska earthquake of March 27, 1964; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
28 the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the United States;  
29 the Honorable Hubert H. Humphrey, Vice President of the United

1 States and President of the Senate; the Honorable John W.  
2 McCormack, Speaker of the House of Representatives; the Honorable  
3 Carl Hayden, President pro tempore of the Senate and Chairman of  
4 the Senate Appropriations Committee; the Honorable Clarence  
5 Cannon, Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee; and the  
6 Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening,  
7 U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Repre-  
8 sentative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
