2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 53

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of  
6 a small boat harbor at the City  
7 of Kenai.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the people of the Kenai, Cook Inlet area derive a  
10 substantial portion of their livelihood from salmon fishing; and

11 WHEREAS the waters of Cook Inlet are constantly being used  
12 in pursuit of this livelihood; and

13 WHEREAS these waters are subject to violent storms and  
14 extreme tides during the fishing season, causing frequent loss  
15 of life and vessels; and

16 WHEREAS the United States Corps of Engineers has conducted  
17 a feasibility study of a small boat harbor for this area and has  
18 recommended its construction;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Congress of the United States is  
20 requested to appropriate to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers  
21 the funds necessary for the construction of a small boat harbor  
22 inside the mouth of the Kenai River adjacent to the City of Kenai,  
23 Alaska; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
25 the Honorable Carl Hayden, Chairman of the Senate Appropriations  
26 Committee; the Honorable George H. Mahon, Chairman of the House  
27 Appropriations Committee; The Honorable Cyrus R. Vance, Secretary  
28 of the Department of the Army; Lt. Gen. Walter K. Wilson, Chief  
29 of Engineers, U. S. Army; Col. Clare D. Farley, District

1 Engineer, Alaska; and the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the  
2 Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable  
3 Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska  
4 delegation in Congress.
