2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 60

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting the construction of  
6 a seawall at Kake, Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the community of Kake, Alaska, is an important fish-  
9 ing and logging center; and

10 WHEREAS the resident fishing fleet at Kake is presently  
11 without any protection from the heavy winter storms; and

12 WHEREAS the expanding logging operations in this area make  
13 the need for a protected anchorage more pressing; and

14 WHEREAS the fishing fleet has sustained storm damage in  
15 excess of \$50,000 over the past three years, mainly because of the  
16 lack of any protection from these storms;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, is  
18 requested to give consideration to the construction of a seawall  
19 at Kake, Alaska.

21 F. Cassidy, Chief of Engineers, U. S. Army; Col. Clare D. Farley,  
22 District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, Alaska; and the Honorable  
23 E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators,  
24 and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative, members  
25 of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
