5 Relating to the Alaska

6 Highway Study of 1965.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, in November of 1963 the Bureau of Public Roads,  
9 Department of Commerce, contracted with Transportation  
10 Consultants, Inc. and Wilbur Smith and Associates in joint  
11 venture to complete a comprehensive study of the highway needs  
12 of the State of Alaska and the attendant fiscal requirements;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the study which is entitled "Alaska Highway Study"  
15 has been completed and was submitted to the Bureau of Public  
16 Roads on March 31, 1965; and

17 WHEREAS, the urgent need for improved highway transporta-  
18 tion in Alaska that moved Congress to authorize the Alaska  
19 Highway Study is now even more critical than it was when the  
20 study was authorized in 1963;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Public Roads, Department  
22 of Commerce, is urgently requested to make public the contents  
23 of the Alaska Highway Study of 1965; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the United States,  
25 the United States Congress, the Bureau of the Budget and the  
26 Bureau of Public Roads are urged to take all necessary steps to  
27 implement the recommendations of the study at the earliest  
28 possible date.

7 Rivers, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation
