9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS one of the greatest natural resources available to
11 the people of Alaska is its supply of reindeer; and

12 WHEREAS the continuing development of the reindeer industry
13 is one of the most advantageous programs that is being carried
14 out for the benefit of the residents of Alaska; and

15 WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs has continuously put
16 forth great effort to enlarge and expand the reindeer industry
17 to the permanent benefit of the residents of Alaska; and

18 WHEREAS the continued efforts of the Bureau of Indian Affairs
19 is evidenced by the recent establishment of a model herd at
20 Nome and in other areas in the state, by the publication and
21 distribution of information concerning the reindeer industry and
22 its potentialities, by attempts to find new markets for the
23 products and by-products of the reindeer industry, and by con-
24 tinued research for new by-products which may be realized from
25 the reindeer industry;

26 BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is commended
27 for its continuous effort to expand and improve the reindeer
28 industry of Alaska and is urged to continue its support in the
29 development of the reindeer industry to the greatest extent
