3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the proposed Captain
6 Cook State Park.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the State of Alaska has selected lands, subject to
9 federal approval, for the creation of a state park; and

10 WHEREAS the selection anticipates the establishment of Captain
11 Cook State Park at Point Possession as an historical park; and

12 WHEREAS with the rapid development in the area of the planned
13 park it is essential that the land selection be approved at an
14 early date so that the park area can be set aside and the necessary
15 planning initiated;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska
17 urges the Department of the Interior to proceed with all possible
18 speed to approve the selection of the State of Alaska of approxi-
19 mately 5,120 acres of land at Point Possession in order that the
20 state can proceed with plans for designation of the site as the
21 Captain Cook State Park.

22 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable
23 Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; and to the Honorable
24 E.L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators,
25 and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative, members
26 of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
