5 Relating to a State conference
6 on alcoholism

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the problem of alcoholism is recognized as being a
9 serious social problem; and

10 WHEREAS the National Institute of Mental Health, upon re-
11 ceiving an acceptable plan, has offered to finance an Alaska
12 State Conference on alcoholism; and

13 WHEREAS the State Department of Health and Welfare has
14 accepted responsibility to develop a Conference Planning
15 Committee; and

16 WHEREAS the Planning Committee is to include, but not be
17 limited to, representation from the State Judiciary, Law
18 Enforcement, Alcoholics Anonymous, Social Agencies, Labor
19 Organizations, Church Groups, the Liquor Industry, Chambers of
20 Commerce, Women's Clubs, Service Clubs, as well as Community
21 Action Groups; and

22 WHEREAS the Conference will have the general broad functions
23 of educating the public as to the problem of alcoholism and the
24 development of recommendations for a formalized State program
25 to answer the problem of alcoholism;

26 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports
27 the planning, implementation and holding of such a Conference
28 and will take into consideration any recommendations developed
29 from the Conference; and be it
