2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 86

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of
6 a seawall at Unalakleet.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the City of Unalakleet is located on federal land
9 and has many federal facilities; and

10 WHEREAS the city is located in an area where there is little
11 or no protection against the sea during storms or from the flood-
12 ing of the Unalakleet River; and

13 WHEREAS high tides, floods, and storms have destroyed land,
14 demolished homes, and endangered the lives of the citizens of
15 Unalakleet; and

16 WHEREAS life and property will continue to be threatened
17 unless an adequate seawall can be constructed to protect the
18 citizens of Unalakleet, especially a seawall from the mouth of
19 the Unalakleet River to the Bureau of Indian Affairs School;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, United States
21 Army, is respectfully urged to construct a seawall at Unalakleet
22 to protect the lives and property of the people living there and
23 for the protection of the federal properties in Unalakleet.
