4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting a study of boarding  
6 facilities for the high schools  
7 at Kotzebue, Unalakleet and  
8 Barrow.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs is exercising its  
11 education responsibilities at Kotzebue, Unalakleet and Barrow  
12 through the construction of high schools; and

13 WHEREAS Kotzebue, Unalakleet and Barrow, upon the completion  
14 of the high schools, will attract students from the general area  
15 who could not otherwise receive a high school education in their  
16 villages; and

17 WHEREAS the influx of students from the areas served will  
18 require boarding facilities to be built in connection with the  
19 Bureau of Indian Affairs high schools;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature requests the  
21 Bureau of Indian Affairs to study the need for boarding facilities  
22 at Kotzebue, Unalakleet and Barrow in conjunction with the new  
23 high schools at those locations so that students from the sur-  
24 rounding areas may also have an opportunity for a high school  
25 education.
