5 Relating to the construction of
6 the world's largest atom smasher
7 in Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS it has been brought to the attention of the Alaska
10 State Legislature that Congress is weighing the merits of approv-
11 ing construction of the world's largest atom smasher at a site
12 which is as yet undetermined; and

13 WHEREAS the State of Alaska abounds in available land of
14 widely diversified terrains; and

15 WHEREAS the people of Alaska would welcome the opportunity
16 to play a greater role in the nation's scientific efforts;

17 BE IT REOLVED that if Congress votes to undertake the con-
18 struction of the proposed scientific facility, the Alaska State
19 Legislature urges the Atomic Energy Commission to select a site in
20 Alaska as the location for the facility's construction.
