3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Proposing that the Constitution  
6 of the State of Alaska be amended  
7 to create school districts as  
8 political subdivisions of the state  
9 with tax assessing and collecting  
10 powers.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 2, Article X, of the Constitution of the State of  
13 Alaska is amended to read:

14 SECTION 2. All local government powers shall be vested  
15 in boroughs, [AND] cities, and school districts. The State  
16 may delegate taxing powers to organized boroughs, [AND]  
17 cities, and school districts only.

18 Article X of the Constitution of the State of Alaska is  
19 amended by adding a new section to read:

20 SECTION 16. A school district shall assess, levy and  
21 collect taxes for school purposes and shall have additional  
22 powers and duties as conferred by law. The governing body  
23 of a school district is the school board.;

24 and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed be-  
26 fore the voters of the state at the next statewide election in  
27 conformity with Section 1, Article XIII, of the Constitution of  
28 the State of Alaska, and the state election code.
