5 Commending the efforts of rescue
6 workers at the Granduc mine
7 disaster.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

9 WHEREAS the recent avalanche disaster at the Granduc mine
10 near Stewart, British Columbia, was met with prompt and often
11 heroic rescue efforts by Alaskan neighbors; and

12 WHEREAS the many individuals involved in the rescue effort
13 performed selflessly and in many cases were exposed to danger
14 and hardship; and

15 WHEREAS these rescue workers are deserving of recognition
16 for their meritorious service;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives commends
18 the following persons and groups for their efforts in the rescue
19 operation: the Ketchikan Volunteer Rescue Squad, the air taxi
20 operators, the scheduled airline operators, the private pilots,
21 the United States Coast Guard air detachment and floating units
22 attached to the Ketchikan operating base, the personnel of the
23 State ferry vessel "Taku" which was sent at the request of Gover-
24 nor Egan, the members of the Ketchikan Medical Association, and
25 the other volunteers, too numerous to mention, who participated
26 in the Granduc mine rescue effort.
