2 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 6

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the Juneau-Taku-
6 Atlin Highway.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the projected Juneau-Taku-Atlin Highway would provide
9 a link in the Pan American Highway and the United States and
10 Canadian transcontinental highway systems; and

11 WHEREAS the projected Juneau-Taku-Atlin Highway would provide
12 year-round access from the capital of Alaska to the population
13 centers of the United States and Canada; and

14 WHEREAS the completion of the Juneau-Taku-Atlin Highway would
15 provide Juneau and the adjacent areas of Southeastern Alaska with
16 advantageous commercial markets for its timber and fisheries pro-
17 ducts; and

18 WHEREAS this highway would make the outstanding tourist
19 attractions of the Juneau area accessible on a year-round basis,
20 thereby providing a means of reducing the deficits incurred by the
21 state ferry system;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to
23 immediately place the Juneau-Taku-Atlin Highway on the present
24 Five-Year Highway Program and commence the programming for this
25 highway.
