

1 IN THE HOUSE BY MR. GUESS
2 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 9
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION
5 Relating to nonstop jet air service
6 between Juneau and Anchorage.
7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
8 WHEREAS Juneau is the capital of Alaska and is also the
9 center of the second largest populated area of Alaska, with a high
10 volume of economic activity; and
11 WHEREAS Anchorage is the largest city in Alaska, and the
12 center of a vast area with a large population and a high degree of
13 economic activity; and
14 WHEREAS the State of Alaska is uniquely dependent upon air
15 transportation of persons, cargo, and mail because of the absence
16 of roads and expeditious surface transportation; and
17 WHEREAS air transportation is vitally essential for Alaskan
18 economic growth and development and the maintenance of communica-
19 tions not only between Anchorage and Juneau but at other com-
20 munities throughout Alaska;
21 BE IT RESOLVED that the proper economic development of Alaska
22 and the maintenance of communications between southeastern and
23 southwestern Alaska require the immediate inauguration of frequent
24 nonstop jet service between Juneau and Anchorage; and be it
25 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
26 the Honorable Alan S. Boyd, Chairman, Civil Aeronautics Board;
27 the Honorable A. G. Woodley, President, Pacific Northern Airlines,
28 Inc.; and the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest
29 Gruening, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U.S.

1 Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
