HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 10

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to a study by the Commis-
sioner of Labor regarding the
hiring practices and handling of
funds by labor unions.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS much of the debate and action of the House of Repre-
sentatives this year has been concerned with the activities of
labor organizations; and

WHEREAS it is the sense of the House that the Legislature
would benefit from an assembly of facts resulting from an investi-
gation of labor union activities in the state, since they have a
vital impact on the economy and progress of Alaska; and

WHEREAS a thorough investigation and report would enable the
Legislature to act in the public interest;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the
Commissioner of Labor to make a thorough investigation of the
activities of labor unions in Alaska, including their hiring
practices and the handling of union funds, and make a full dis-
closure of his findings to the public through the Legislature by
submitting his report no later than the convening date of the
Second Session of the Fourth Legislature in January 1966.
