5 Requesting a study of boarding
6 facilities for the high schools
7 at Kotzebue and Barrow.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

9 WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs is exercising its
10 education responsibilities at Kotzebue and Barrow through the
11 construction of high schools; and

12 WHEREAS Kotzebue and Barrow, upon the completion of the
13 high schools, will attract students from the general area who
14 could not otherwise receive a high school education in their
15 villages; and

16 WHEREAS the influx of students from the areas served will
17 require boarding facilities to be built in connection with the
18 Bureau of Indian Affairs high schools;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives requests
20 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to study the need for boarding
21 facilities at Kotzebue and Barrow in conjunction with the new
22 high schools at those locations so that students from the
23 surrounding areas may also have an opportunity for a high school
24 education.
