5 Relating to the paving of the
6 Lunch Creek and Beaver Falls
7 extensions of the Tongass
8 Highway.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

10 WHEREAS the Tongass Highway is the only major highway in the
11 Ketchikan area; and

12 WHEREAS the Lunch Creek extension of the North Tongass
13 Highway provides access to a camping and picnic complex, recently
14 developed by the Forest Service, which is a prime tourist attrac-
15 tion; and

16 WHEREAS the Beaver Falls extension of the South Tongass
17 Highway provides access to the municipal power works as well as
18 to recreational and timber areas; and

19 WHEREAS both the Lunch Creek and Beaver Falls extensions
20 also serve rapidly-growing residential areas; and

21 WHEREAS the present and projected traffic loads on these
22 roadways make it necessary that these extensions be paved as soon
23 as possible;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Highways is requested
25 to include the paving of the Lunch Creek and Beaver Falls exten-
26 sions of the Tongass Highway in its five-year program for
27 secondary road system improvements.
