HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 13

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting the Governor of Alaska
to adjourn the Fourth State Legis-
lature.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS Section 10, Article II, of the Constitution of the
State of Alaska, authorizes the Governor to adjourn the Legisla-
ture on the request of one house of the Legislature; and

WHEREAS the First Session of this Legislature appropriated
funds to permit the Second Session of this Legislature to stay in
session for a maximum of 70 days; and

WHEREAS it is apparent that the two houses of this Legisla-
ture are now in disagreement as to the time when this Legislature
must adjourn; and

WHEREAS the problems which have developed in the other body
are such that this House can no longer work in harmony with our
colleagues in the Senate and cannot agree when this Legislature
must adjourn;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives certifies
to the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska, that the two
houses of this Legislature are in disagreement on the time of
adjournment and this House respectfully requests the Governor to
adjourn this Legislature at 11:59 p.m., Sunday, April 3, 1966.
