7 and use of tanker docking  
8 facilities on the western shore  
9 of Cook Inlet.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

11 WHEREAS the petroleum industry operating in the Cook Inlet  
12 area oil fields has announced plans for the construction of a  
13 petroleum tanker port; and

14 WHEREAS the proposed docking facility will be located on  
15 the west side of Cook Inlet in the vicinity of Kalgin Island; and

16 WHEREAS the southwest Alaska state ferry system operates in  
17 Cook Inlet and the possibility of beneficial cooperation between  
18 the state and the petroleum industry in developing the western  
19 shore of Cook Inlet is suggested;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested  
21 to direct the Department of Public Works to explore the possi-  
22 bility of cooperation with the petroleum interests which plan to  
23 construct a tanker docking facility on the western shore of Cook  
24 Inlet to the end that the docking facility could be constructed  
25 to accommodate the state ferry operating in the area with benefits  
26 accruing to industry and the state through the development of  
27 auxiliary facilities and promoting access to and development of  
28 the area west of Cook Inlet.
