6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to grants of state land in
7 place of property made unsuitable for use by
8 the natural disaster of March 27, 1964; and
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 116, SLA 1964, is amended to read:

12 Section 1. The director of the division of lands may
13 make grants of state land to persons and municipal corpora-
14 tions to replace land which was rendered unsuitable [UNUSABLE]
15 for private residential, business, or commercial [THE] pur-
16 poses [FOR WHICH IT WAS USED ON MARCH 27, 1964,] by shifts in
17 the land mass caused by the natural disaster of March 27,
18 1964. The director shall designate state land which is avail-
19 able to replace land rendered unsuitable [UNUSABLE].

20 * Sec. 2. Sec. 2, Ch. 116, SLA 1964, is amended to read:

21 Sec. 2. Persons are eligible for grants of state land
22 only if the land which was rendered unsuitable was [UNUSABLE
23 IS] owned by them [AND WAS USED OR LEASED] on or before March
24 27, 1964 [, FOR PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL, BUSINESS, OR COMMERCIAL
25 PURPOSES]. A person who incurred a binding obligation to
26 purchase land, on or before March 27, 1964, shall be con-
27 sidered the owner of the land for the purpose of this Act.

28 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
29 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
