10 * Section 1. AS 14.20.170(1) is amended to read:

11 (1) incompetency, which is defined as the in-
12 ability or the unintentional or intentional failure to
13 perform the teacher's customary teaching [ONE'S LEGITIMATE]
14 duties in a satisfactory manner;

15 * Sec. 2. AS 14.20.170(2) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

16 (2) immorality, which is defined as the commission
17 of an act which, under the laws of the state, constitutes a
18 crime involving moral turpitude; or
