6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring three years' service by a
7 teacher after sabbatical leave; and provid-
8 ing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.20.320 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 14.20.320. RESPONSIBILITY OF TEACHERS. Upon a
12 teacher's return to his teaching position, the teacher shall
13 make a report to the authority which approved his sabbatical
14 leave concerning his educational accomplishments. A teacher
15 who does not serve for at least three [A] full years [YEAR]
16 after his return shall refund to the department any money
17 paid to him under secs. 280 - 350 of this chapter unless his
18 failure to serve three [A] full years [YEAR] after return is
19 attributable to sickness, injury, [OR] death, or involuntary
20 nonretention.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1965.
