6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to allow the limitation of drivers'
7 licenses by the courts and the Department of
8 Public Safety; and providing for an effec-
9 tive date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 28.15 is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 Sec. 28.15.195. LIMITED LICENSE. (a) After conviction
14 of any violation of this chapter, whether or not mandatory
15 suspension of the operator's license is required, the court
16 in which the conviction occurs may limit the license on its
17 face and return it to the person convicted if the license
18 is necessary to his livelihood. The court shall forward the
19 record of the conviction and limitation of license to the
20 department.

21 (b) Upon receipt of the record of conviction and limi-
22 tation of license from the court, the department shall notify
23 the court of its concurrence with the limitation, or, if it
24 does not concur, it shall notify the court to obtain and
25 forward the license to the department.

26 (c) A person whose license is suspended or revoked by
27 the department under this chapter may apply at any time for
28 a limited license.

29 (d) A limited license is one which may be limited to

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
