6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making kindergartens of public
7 schools eligible for Public School Foun-
8 dation Program aid; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 14.17.050 is amended by adding a new subsec-
12 tion to read:

13 (1) In computing the allotment under this section, two
14 pupils in average daily membership in kindergarten are
15 counted as one pupil in average daily membership in other
16 elementary school grades.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.060 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 14.17.060. AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP ALLOTMENT.

19 (a) The average daily membership allotment for each district
20 is as follows:

21 (1) if the district is in the Southeastern Senate
22 District: \$140 times average daily membership;

23 (2) if the district is in the Southcentral Senate
24 District: \$150 times average daily membership;

25 (3) if the district is in the Central and North-
26 west Senate Districts and that part of the Southcentral
27 Senate District lying west of 152° west longitude: \$160
28 times the average daily attendance.

29 (b) In computing the allotment under this section, two

an appropriate combination of grades within this range;
