FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to recording precincts."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 22.05.160. is amended to read:

Sec. 22.05.160. RECORDING PRECINCTS [DISTRICTS]. The
supreme court shall divide the state into recording precincts
and define the boundaries of the precincts and may [IS
EMPOWERED TO ESTABLISH,] modify or discontinue recording
[DISTRICTS OR] precincts. [; TO] The supreme court shall
prescribe the records to be maintained and the instruments
to be recorded and the accounting for recording fees, [;TO]
engage and compensate recorders, deputy recorders and clerks,
[TO] require magistrates to act as recorders where, and to
the extent, necessary, [;TO] prescribe recording fees and
[TO] do all things necessary to maintain the recording
system [ESTABLISHED UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS STATE].
