6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the state election code;
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 15.25.020 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 15.25.020. DATE OF PRIMARY. The party primary
11 nomination is held on the fourth Tuesday [AFTER THE SECOND
12 MONDAY] in August of [IN] every even numbered year.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 15.20.080 is amended to read:

14 Sec. 15.20.080. DATE FOR APPLICATION IN PERSON. A
15 qualified voter may apply for an absentee ballot in person
16 on any day not more than 15 [30] days before the day of an
17 election, but not on election day. For special elections
18 held to recall an elected official or to fill a vacancy in
19 the office of United States representative or governor and
20 secretary of state, a qualified voter may apply for an
21 absentee ballot 20 days before the date of an election but
22 not on election day.

23 * Sec. 3. AS 15.25.040(a) is amended to read:

24 (a) The declaration is filed by either

25 (1) the actual physical delivery of the declara-
26 tion by mail or in person at or before 5:00 p.m., Alaska
27 Standard time, June [MAY] 1 of the year in which a general
28 election is held for the office, or

29 (2) the actual physical delivery by telegram of

1 a copy in substance of the statements made in the declaration
2 at or before 5:00 p.m., Alaska Standard time, June [MAY] 1 of
3 the year in which a general election is held for the office,
4 and also the actual physical delivery of the original decla-
5 ration postmarked at or before 5:00 p.m., Alaska Standard
6 time, June [MAY] 1 of the year in which a general election is
7 held for the office.

8 * Sec. 4. AS 15.25.040(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) If June [MAY] 1 is a Sunday or holiday, the
10 declaration may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., Alaska
11 Standard time on the following day.

12 * Sec. 5. AS 15.10.110 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 15.10.110. APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION SUPERVISORS.
14 The secretary of state shall appoint an election supervisor
15 for each of the four major senate districts described in
16 sec. 2 , art. XIV, of the state constitution to assist in the
17 administration of elections within their respective senate
18 districts. The secretary of state may appoint as an election
19 supervisor a person who is a qualified voter of the respec-
20 tive senate district and who does not hold an office in a
21 political party. An election supervisor shall be appointed
22 to serve for a term to begin not more than 120 [90] days
23 before the date of the primary nomination or special election
24 and to end not more than 30 days after the date of the
25 general or special election. An election supervisor is
26 entitled to receive compensation in an amount that is com-
27 parable to that received for similar state employment as
28 determined by the secretary of state. Executive department
29 employees shall be appointed election supervisors whenever

1 feasible and shall serve without additional compensation.

2 * Sec. 6. AS 15.20.500 is repealed.

3 * Sec. 7. This Act takes effect May 1, 1966.
