6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of den-
7 tists; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.36.110(4) is amended to read:

10 (4) a graduate of a dental college approved by
11 the [BOARD] Council on Dental Education of the American
12 Dental Association and the American Association of Dental
13 Examiners at the time of graduation, and holds a D.D.S. or
14 D.M.D. degree or the equivalent;

15 * Sec. 2. AS 08.36.220 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 08.36.220. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY.
17 If an applicant having the qualifications contained in
18 secs. 110 and 210 of this chapter has been engaged in the
19 practice of dentistry for a period of two [FIVE] years in
20 a state, territory, district or possession of the United
21 States, immediately preceding his application to practice
22 in the state, the board shall license the applicant without
23 examination.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 08.36.270 is repealed.

25 * Sec. 4. AS 08.36.280 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

26 Sec. 08.36.280. TEMPORARY PERMIT. (a) The board
27 shall issue a one year temporary permit without examination
28 to an applicant to practice dentistry in a locality requested
29 by the applicant if the locality is of the type specified

1 in (a)(2) of this section and the applicant

2 (1) meets the requirements of sec. 110 of this
3 chapter;

4 (2) desires to practice dentistry in a city or
5 rural village which

6 (1) does not have a resident licensed den-
7 tist in active general practice,

8 (ii) has a population of less than 3,000
9 people as determined by the best available census in-
10 formation, and

11 (iii) is beyond a 25 mile radius of the
12 nearest office of a resident licensed dentist;

13 (3) has a license in good standing to practice
14 dentistry in a state, territory, district or possession of
15 the United States;

16 (4) tenders and pays the fee prescribed in sec.
17 290(6) of this chapter.

18 (b) The board may authorize a temporary permittee to
19 practice dentistry in more than one city or rural village
20 of the type specified in (a)(2) of this section.

21 (c) The board shall annually renew a temporary permit
22 upon written application of an applicant and upon payment of
23 the prescribed fee if the applicant has not committed an
24 act which is a ground for revocation in sec. 310 of this
25 chapter.

26 (d) A temporary permit may be revoked, suspended or
27 annulled, or the permittee may be reprimanded, censured or
28 disciplined by the board in the same manner and for the
29 same cause as a licensed dentist under sec. 310 of this

(e) The board shall grant or deny an application for a temporary permit within 60 days after it is received.

* Sec. 5. AS 08.36 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 08.36.285. LICENSING A PERMITTEE. The board shall issue a license without examination to an applicant who has held a permit under sec. 280 of this chapter for five consecutive years or more unless the applicant has committed an act which is a ground for revocation in sec. 310 of this chapter.

* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
