10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 22.15 is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 Sec. 22.15.145. RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY. A person
14 charged with any crime or any violation of an ordinance of
15 a political subdivision has the right to a speedy and public
16 trial by jury of six persons, when the penalty provided by
17 law or ordinance is a fine of at least \$300, or confinement
18 in a penal institution, or both.
