10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 11.30 is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 Sec. 11.30.265. ✓ FALSE AND FRAUDULENT STATEMENTS AND
14 CLAIMS PROHIBITED. No person shall, with regard to any
15 matter within the jurisdiction of any department or agency
16 of the State of Alaska, knowingly and willfully:

17 (1) falsify, conceal or cover up by any trick,
18 scheme or device, a material fact; or

19 (2) make any false, fictitious or fraudulent
20 statement or representation, either orally or in writing; or

21 (3) make or use any false writing or documents
22 knowing the same to contain any false, fictitious or fraudu-
23 lent statement or entry; or

24 (4) make or present any claim upon or against the
25 State of Alaska or any department or agency thereof, knowing
26 such claim to be false, fictitious or fraudulent.

27 A person convicted of any offense under this section is
28 guilty of a misdemeanor and is punishable by imprisonment for
29 not to exceed one year, or by a fine not to exceed \$5,000,
