6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the manner of designating  
7 a lode claim location."

8 \* Section 1. AS 27.10.030 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 27.10.030 ✓ MANNER OF DESIGNATING A LODE CLAIM  
10 LOCATION. The discoverer of a lode claim shall designate the  
11 location as follows:

12 (1) by posting at the northeast corner of the  
13 claim [ON THE SURFACE AT OR ADJACENT TO THE POINT OF DIS-  
14 COVERY] a plain sign or notice containing

15 (A) the name of the lode claim;

16 (B) the name of the locator or locators;

17 (C) the date of the location;

18 (D) the approximate bearings of corners and  
19 angle posts of the claim and the distances between them;

20 [NUMBER OF FEET IN LENGTH CLAIMED ALONG THE VEIN EACH WAY  
21 FROM THE POINT OF DISCOVERY, AND THE WIDTH ON EACH SIDE OF  
22 THE CENTER OF SUCH LODE OR VEIN:] and

23 (2) by erecting [ON THE VEIN AT THE CENTER OF EACH  
24 END LINE AND] at each corner or angle of the claim substantial  
25 monuments of stone or setting posts, not less than three feet  
26 in height nor less than three inches in diameter hewn and  
27 marked with the name of the claim, the position or number of  
28 the monument and the direction of the boundary lines, and by  
29 cutting out, blazing or marking the boundary lines so that

they can be readily traced. Where it is impracticable to place a monument in its true position, a witness monument shall be erected and marked [SO AS] to indicate the true position of the corner or angle.
