6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to appeals from Workmen's
7 Compensation Board decisions; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.30.125(c) is amended to read as follows:

11 (c) If not in accordance with law, a compensation
12 order may be suspended or set aside, in whole or in part,
13 through injunction proceedings in the superior court brought
14 by a party in interest against the board and all other
15 parties to the proceedings before the board. [IN THE SUPER-
16 IOR COURT.] The payment of the amounts required by an award
17 may not be stayed pending final decision in the proceeding
18 unless upon application for an interlocutory injunction the
19 court on hearing, after not less than three days' notice to
20 the parties in interest and the board, allows the stay of
21 payment, in whole or in part, where irreparable damage would
22 otherwise ensue to the employer. The order of the court
23 allowing a stay shall contain a specific finding, based
24 upon evidence submitted to the court and identified by
25 reference to it, that irreparable damage would result to the
26 employer, and specifying the nature of the damage.

27 * Sec. 2. This act takes effect on the day after its passage
28 and approval, or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
