6 For an Act entitled: "An Act designating the sites for the build-
7 ings to be constructed for and used by the
8 Youth and Adult Authority and the Department
9 of Health and Welfare under ch. 118, SLA
10 1964; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. SITE DESIGNATION. Under provisions of sec. 1,
13 ch. 118, SLA 1964 (Bonding Proposition No. 2, as approved by the
14 voters of the state on November 3, 1964) the legislature directs
15 that a jail facility be constructed at Fairbanks and a juvenile
16 detention and treatment facility be constructed at Anchorage.
17 Approximately \$2,000,000 may be used for the Fairbanks facility
18 and the balance of the authorized \$5,000,000 or so much as may be
19 needed and available, may be used for the facility at Anchorage.
20 The governor shall make the specific site and expenditure deter-
21 minations consistent with the provisions of this section.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
23 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
