6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pay for home super-
7 visors of correspondence course pupils; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.05 is amended by adding a new section to
11 read:

12 Sec. 14.05.170. HOME SUPERVISORS. (a) The Department
13 of Education shall adopt procedural and substantive regula-
14 tions to administer this section.

15 (b) A person who, in the home area, assumes primary
16 responsibility for supervising the education of a child who
17 is receiving his public school education by a correspondence
18 course provided and paid for by the state, is entitled to
19 compensation.

20 (c) The department shall pay the person, for each cor-
21 respondence course completed by a child he is supervising,
22 one-half the difference between the average annual cost to
23 the state of

24 (1) educating a pupil in the rural school system;
25 and

26 (2) educating a pupil by correspondence.

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
28 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
