6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to residence of the men-
7 tally ill."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 47.30.340(13) is amended to read:

10 (13) "resident" means a person who has been phys-
11 cally present and lived continuously in the state for one
12 year [;]. If a resident voluntarily leaves the state and
13 is absent for one year he ceases to be a resident of the
14 state. However, in the case of residents from states where
15 there is no reciprocal agreement or the interstate compact
16 provisions in secs. 10 - 340 do not apply, the requirements
17 necessary to gain residence in this state shall not be less
18 than those required for the acquisition of residence in the
19 state from which the non resident comes. A married woman
20 may establish a residence apart from her husband, and an
21 unemancipated minor takes the residence of the parent or
22 guardian with whom he is living;
