6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to rural signs."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 19.25.100 is amended to read:

9       Sec. 19.25.100. RURAL SIGNS. As soon as practical,  
10 the department shall, utilizing Alaskan motif, design  
11 identical or nearly identical signs for highway use by  
12 rural business. Each sign shall list the type of establish-  
13 ment, service offered and the distance to it. Each owner  
14 or manager of the rural establishment shall install the  
15 sign at his own expense, upon application and issuance of a  
16 permit by the department. Where practicable, a sign author-  
17 ized under this section shall be installed within two miles  
18 [ONE MILE] from and on the right side of all highway ap-  
19 proaches to the establishment. Where practicable, one sign  
20 may indicate several businesses and the distance to each.
