6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a Governor's Native Af-
7 fairs Advisory Board."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding new sections to
10 read:

11 ARTICLE 10. NATIVE AFFAIRS ADVISORY BOARD.

12 Sec. 44.19.710. BOARD CREATED. There is created a
13 Native Affairs Advisory Board consisting of seven members
14 appointed by the governor. One member each shall be ap-
15 pointed from the Aleut, Eskimo, Athabaskan, Haida, and
16 Thlingit communities and two members of the board shall be
17 appointed to serve as public members. Members serve for
18 three-year terms but for the purposes of the initial appoint-
19 ments under this section four shall serve for three-year
20 terms and three for two-year terms.

21 Sec. 44.19.720. BOARD ACTIVITIES. The board shall
22 elect a chairman. The board shall adopt rules and regula-
23 tions for the conduct of its meetings and meet at least twice
24 a year. The board shall keep a record of all its trans-
25 actions. Members are entitled to the transportation and per
26 diem allowances provided for members of boards by general
27 law. The board shall give public notice of the time and
28 place of each meeting.

29 Sec. 44.19.730, BOARD PURPOSE. It is the purpose of

the board to annually report to the governor and the legislature on its review of the condition, problems, and needs of the Native people of the state and the communities and areas in which they live. The board shall examine, study and report on education, health, employment, area development, and other matters as they pertain to the Native citizens of the state in particular and to the welfare and progress of the state in general. The annual report of the board shall include its findings and recommendations.
