6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to public schools."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS ~~14.15~~.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 14.15.010. DIVISIONS. The divisions of the state  
10 public school system are as follows:

11 (1) each first, second, and third class city in  
12 the unorganized borough is a city school district;

13 (2) each organized borough is a borough school  
14 district;

15 (3) schools outside organized boroughs and outside  
16 first, second, and third class cities are state-operated  
17 schools.

18 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.15.240 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

19 Sec. 14.15.240. SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND MAINTENANCE. The  
20 city council shall provide the city school district with the  
21 funds the council deems necessary to construct school build-  
22 ings and maintain public schools.

23 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.15.250 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

24 Sec. 14.15.250. SCHOOL BOARD. City schools are under  
25 the supervision and control of a school board of five members.  
26 The board shall have all necessary power to operate and  
27 maintain schools and to supervise, manage, hire and dismiss  
28 personnel of the schools, except the following powers, which  
29 are reserved to the city council:
