SENATE BILL NO. 125

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons admitted to the Pioneer's Home; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.25\020(b) and (c) are amended to read:

(b) Every person admitted to the Pioneer's Home, except a person admitted under sec. 30 of this chapter, who receives income from any source in excess of \$20 [\$15] a month may be required by the office of the governor to pay the excess to the office of the governor immediately upon receipt of the money in payment, or part payment, of the cost of his maintenance.

(c) At the end of each month the payments made under (b) of this section shall be transmitted to the commissioner of revenue together with the names of the persons making them and the amount paid by each. The office of the governor may pay the sum of \$15 [\$10] a month to a resident without funds.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1965.
