6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to old age assistance pay-
7 ments; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 47.25.430(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Financial assistance shall be given under secs.
11 430 - 610 of this chapter, so far as practicable under the
12 conditions in the state, to every aged, needy resident of the
13 state who has resided in the state for five years during the
14 nine years immediately preceding the date of application, who
15 has attained the age of 65 years, and who has not made a
16 voluntary assignment or transfer of property to qualify for
17 assistance. Assistance shall be in an amount which will pro-
18 vide the applicant with a reasonable subsistence compatible
19 with decency and health, but shall in no case exceed the rate
20 of \$140 [\$110] a calendar month. Direct payments for medical
21 services and remedial care shall not be considered in deter-
22 mining the maximum amount payable.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1965.
