6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of intoxicating  
7 liquor."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.15.020(e) is amended to read:

10 (e) Churches and schools. The board shall not issue a  
11 beverage dispensary license or package liquor store license  
12 for the sale of any intoxicating liquor in any building  
13 within 200 feet of a school ground or church building  
14 measured by the shortest direct line from the school ground  
15 or church building in which religious services are conducted,  
16 within or without any corporate municipality [NOR FOR USE IN  
17 ANY BUILDING WITHIN TWO MILES OF AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR  
18 UNIVERSITY CERTIFIED BY NORTHWEST ASSOCIATION FOR THE AC-  
19 CREDITING OF INSTITUTIONS OF FORMAL EDUCATION]. A license  
20 may be reissued or transferred from one licensee to another,  
21 for the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building in which  
22 that sale was authorized by law on April 25, 1960. When a  
23 license for the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building  
24 within 200 feet of a school ground or church building in  
25 which religious services are conducted is forfeited, lapses  
26 or is transferred to other premises, no license for the sale  
27 of intoxicating liquor at the prior licensed location shall  
28 thereafter be issued. However, the location may be relicensed  
29 in the event of the removal of either cause of the
