6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salaries of judges
7 of the supreme and superior courts; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140 (a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The chief justice shall receive \$25,500 [\$23,500]
12 annually, and each associate justice shall receive \$24,500
13 [\$22,500] annually as compensation. The compensation is
14 payable monthly in 12 equal installments. Compensation of
15 the chief justice or of an associate justice shall not
16 be diminished during his term of office, unless by general
17 law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

19 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$21,000
20 [\$19,000] annually, as compensation, payable monthly in
21 12 equal installments. The compensation of a judge shall
22 not be diminished during his term of office, unless by
23 general law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1965.
